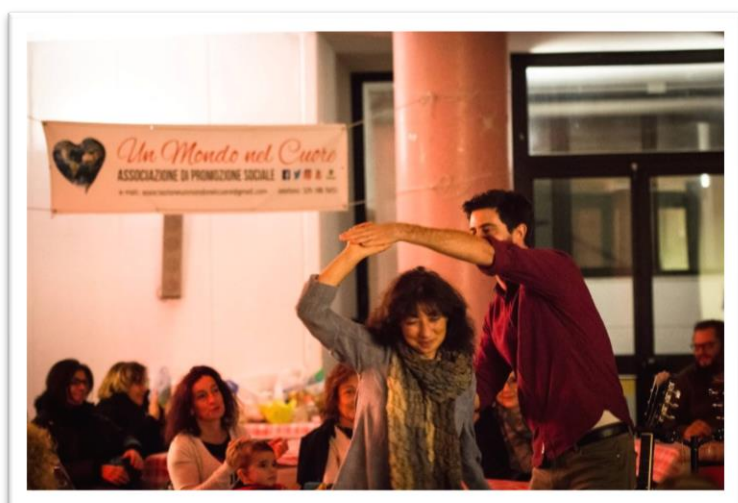


Simone Saccucci
